What is NDAA?

Notre Dame ACE Academies are Catholic schools that have a special partnership with the Alliance for Catholic Education (ACE) and the University of Notre Dame. There are currently 14 Notre Dame ACE Academies throughout the United States. Within the Archdiocese of Indianapolis, Central Catholic, Holy Angels, Holy Cross, St. Anthony and St. Philip Neri comprise the ACE Academies. All are located in the downtown Indianapolis, center-city area and serve a struggling socio-economic population. The goal of the NDAA partnership is to provide a Catholic education of the highest quality to as many children as possible. For the children we serve, **we have two simple goals: college and heaven.**

NDAA Facts:

- Of the 1,090 NDAA students in Indianapolis, 78% are Catholic; 22% are non-Catholic.
- Approximately 94% of the students we serve are eligible for vouchers. 100% of our families receive tuition assistance through tax credit scholarships and/or archdiocesan aid.
- We are proud of our racial/ethnic diversity: 70% Latino; 14% White; 12% African-American; 3% Multiracial; 1% Other
- 496 students (just over 45% of total population) receive extra support as English Language Learners (English is a new language for many of the students we serve).
- 87 students are identified with special learning needs (nearly 5% of total population). This does not include students who receive interventions for learning differences who are not eligible for special education services.
- 100% of the students we serve are made in the image and likeness of God. Each has wonderful gifts to share, and it is our responsibility and privilege to elevate the capacity of every student daily!
